



Dear Valued Memorial Hermann In the Pink of Health Supporter:

This year, we celebrate 25 incredible years since the first Memorial Hermann In the Pink of Health Luncheon. Thanks to your generosity, since our inception, we have invested \$9.1 million in state-of-the-art technology, prevention, community outreach, and education—all dedicated to the fight against breast and ovarian cancer.

In 2024, your meaningful contributions empowered us to grant \$550,000 to our charity partners across Montgomery County. In January, the Allocations Committee met and made the following distributions to our partner organizations:

The Canopy Cancer Survivorship Center,

located on Memorial Hermann The Woodlands's campus, received \$225,000 to ensure that its myriad programs for cancer patients and their families remain free of charge. \$85.000 was allocated to purchase wigs, wig care kits, breast prostheses, and other items for cancer patients through the oncology nurse navigator at **Memorial Hermann The Woodlands.** The **Interfaith Community Clinic** received **\$7,500** to increase outreach to uninsured and underinsured patients and to help provide access to free mammograms through In the Pink of Health, \$100,000 was allocated to provide free mammograms at the **Breast Care Center at** Memorial Hermann The Woodlands Medical Center. \$52,500 was set aside for future stateof-the-art technology for the **Breast Care** Center at Memorial Hermann The Woodlands. **The Rose** received **\$55,000** to support breast screenings, diagnostics, and cancer treatment

for women in Montgomery County, and **Ovarcome** received **\$25,000** to further its mission to increase ovarian cancer awareness and to provide financial support for ovarian cancer patients in Montgomery County.

Together with a dedicated committee, we are honored to co-chair this initiative that provides essential financial support to residents of Montgomery County affected by breast and ovarian cancer. While cancer rates among women in the United States tragically continue to rise (1 in 8 will face breast cancer and 1 in 91 will face ovarian cancer), your unwavering support and generosity have made a transformative difference and remain vital to the success of our mission.

We kindly request your support of Memorial Hermann In the Pink of Health and our missions to reduce the incidence of breast and ovarian cancer and assist survivors in their journeys.

We look forward to celebrating with you at our 25th Annual Luncheon on October 24 at The Woodlands Waterway Marriott.

You might recognize Giuliana and Bill Rancic as the dynamic duo from the hit reality series, *Giuliana and Bill*, but their impact reaches far beyond the screen. While their shared journey has inspired millions, each brings a powerful and inspiring story to the partnership.

Giuliana Rancic is an award-winning entertainment journalist, television personality, and *New York Times* best-selling author. As the longtime host of *E! News,* she has graced the red carpets of Hollywood's biggest events, interviewing stars at the Oscars and Grammys. Off-camera, Giuliana is also a successful fashion designer, entrepreneur, and restaurateur.

After being diagnosed with breast cancer in 2011, she courageously shared her experience with the world and founded Fab-U-Wish, a program that grants fashion and beauty-themed wishes to women undergoing treatment. She remains a passionate advocate for organizations like The Pink Agenda and the Breast Cancer Research Foundation.

Bill Rancic is a celebrated entrepreneur, best-selling author, and motivational speaker who rose to prominence as the first winner of *The Apprentice*. As a lifelong student of business, Bill continues to inspire audiences with his insights on leadership, resilience, and overcoming uncertainty. He has authored four books, including the *New York Times* best-seller, *You're Hired*, and the relationship memoir, *I Do ... Now What?*, co-written with Giuliana.

Together, Bill and Giuliana are partners in the RPM Restaurant Group (with locations in Chicago, Las Vegas, and Washington, D.C.), as well as founders of Giuliana Prosecco. Their philanthropic efforts include supporting multiple breast cancer organizations and Mercy Home for Boys & Girls in Chicago. They currently reside in Chicago with their 12-year-old son, Duke.

Did You Know

Breast cancer is the most common cancer diagnosed among women in the United States and is the second leading cause of death from cancer among women.

Ovarian cancer is the fifth leading cause of cancer deaths among women. A woman's lifetime chance of dying from ovarian cancer is about 1 in 130. Her risk of getting ovarian cancer during her lifetime is about 1 in 91.






